

SUPREME PERSON

A venue may only be entered in a single category per membership. Nominees may enter multiple People & Excellence categories. The Awards are to recognise the contribution made in the past year and based on accomplishments in the 1 October – 30 September period.

ELIGIBILITY

All categories are open to full EVANZ members and their employees.

To be eligible, nominees must be a fully paid up Venue Member or employee as of 1 October 2018. Non-current members and their employees are ineligible for nomination.

JUDGING CRITERIA

There are specific criteria with every nomination. Judges will be looking for specific examples of the criteria outlined on the nomination form and evidence of their presence and impact on either the venue or its outcomes. Wherever possible provide supporting evidence in your submission of the criteria being addressed and its impacts.

Each entry submission should be around 1,000 – 1,500 words and supporting evidence can be provided. Please keep evidence to no more than one attachment per criteria.

SCORING

Scoring will be done using a points based system. Each assessment criteria in each award category will be eligible for points. The total of points from each assessment criteria will form the total points awarded. Point values for each assessment criteria are in the judges scoring information.

In the event of a draw, the EVANZ President will score the drawn submissions to break a deadlock.

The three nominees with the highest points total will be declared finalists announced on 1 November with the winners announced at the Awards Dinner on 27 November 2018.

SUPREME AWARDS

Winners in the supreme categories will be taken from the venue and people nominees respectively. The venue and person with the highest score in each award category will be the winner.

THE JUDGING PANEL

Each Awards section has its own team of three judges. These judges are assembled from the Association Executive and industry contributors who are able to give an independent and knowledgeable assessment to their given categories. No Awards sponsors or Associate Members are on any part of the judging panel. Does not apply to the Host Responsibility Award.

In the event the Association Secretary or a judge identifies a conflict with a nomination, the judge will be excused from judging that nomination and it will be given to an alternative executive or industry judge.

The judges will score nominations independent of each other and without conversation or knowledge of the others' scores. Only the Association Secretary will know who has won each category and this will be revealed at the Awards Dinner on 27 November.

FINALISTS ANNOUNCEMENTS

Finalists will be announced on the EVANZ Facebook page and website on 7 November.
